

# Diss Mix Fertilizer Instructions

## Materials Needed

Item	Description
Diss Mix Fertilizer	12 ounces of concentrated fertilizer
Water	20 ounces of clean water
Kitchen Mixer	For proper mixing and clay shearing
Mason Jar	With lid for making spreader
Straw	For spreader construction

## Mixing Instructions

1. **Combine ingredients:** Mix 12 ounces of Diss Mix Fertilizer with 20 ounces of water in your kitchen mixer.
2. **Shear the clay:** Run the mixer for exactly 5 minutes to properly break down clay particles and ensure uniform consistency.
3. **Rinse equipment:** Clean the mixer thoroughly with fresh water after mixing.

 **Final yield: 32 ounces • Coverage: 400 square feet**

## DIY Spreader Construction

4. **Prepare a mason jar lid:** Drill or punch 2 small holes in the mason jar lid.
5. **Insert straw:** Place a drinking straw through one hole, ensuring it reaches the bottom of the jar.
6. **Create air flow:** The second hole allows air to enter as liquid flows out through the straw, creating controlled dispensing.

## Application Instructions

7. **Fill spreader:** Pour the mixed fertilizer solution into your DIY spreader.
8. **Apply to soil:** Turn jar upside down and sprinkle the liquid fertilizer evenly across the target area.
9. **Work into soil:** Mix the applied fertilizer into the soil using a rake or hoe for best results.
